

**Roger Furniss** is a national authority on riverine and fishing matters. He is Chairman of the South West Rivers Association; he was formerly Environmental Protection Manager and later Director of Public Affairs at South West Water; and a founder director of the Angling Trust, the National Governing Body for fishing.

**Ted Hughes**, the late Poet Laureate, fisherman and 'Honorary Devonian', lived in mid-Devon from the 1960's. He was a keen fisherman and a founder trustee of the Westcountry Rivers Trust.
