Be kind to the land

- Stick to footpaths and bridleways to reduce erosion and damage to our moors and woodland.
- If you see any litter, please pick it up if it's safe to do so and dispose in nearby bins.
- Fire can significantly harm our landscape, so do not use stoves or BBQ's on moorlands or woodlands, only in safe, designated areas.

Be kind to wildlife

- Enjoy wildlife from a distance, particularly in the Spring and early Summer as they might have young nearby.
- If you spot any young animals, leave them in peace as mum will be nearby.
- Avoid damaging plants and trees on your adventure as these offer homes and food for thousands of different animals.
- Keep dogs on leads when on the moor as their presence will disturb breeding birds.

Be kind to people & property

- Be polite to other walkers and people that you meet.
- Keep away from farm machinery
- Don't climb over walls, fences or private gates. Use styles and gates provided on public footpaths.
- Close all gates behind you and keep your distance from livestock.
